

2026 International Workshop on ATM/CNS (IWAC2026) General Information for Authors

Important Dates

- Submission Deadline: ~~April 24, 2026~~ **May 15, 2026**
- Notification of Acceptance : **June 30, 2026**
- Final Paper Submission Deadline: **August 31, 2026**
- On-line Registration Deadline (Presenters): **August 31, 2026**
- On-line Registration Deadline (Participants): **November 19, 2026**
- Workshop period: **November 17-19, 2026**

General Guidelines

All submissions to IWAC2026 must meet the following minimum requirements in order to be considered for acceptance:

- IWAC2026 solicits papers for Academic and Interchange Categories.
Authors should select the appropriate Category according to the objective of their submission.
- **Academic Category:** Academic research submissions
 - ✓ Submissions in the Academic Category are reviewed through a peer-review process
 - ✓ Papers submitted to and accepted in this category will be considered for four awards:
 - Best Paper Award
 - Best Student Paper Award
 - Best Poster Award
 - Best Student Poster Award.
- **Interchange Category:** Non-academic presentations such as introductions of projects/products, and proposals for aircraft operations/supporting technologies etc...
- All papers must be written in English.
- Papers must be submitted electronically via the Workshop's Online Submission System

- In both the Academic and Interchange categories, presenters are required to select either an oral or a poster presentation. Please note that some papers submitted for oral presentation may be assigned to poster presentations in acceptance due to limited oral presentation slots.

Academic Category – Paper Submission

- Paper selection in the Academic Category will be based on full paper submissions. Authors **must prepare a manuscript of 4 – 8 pages** including all text, figures and references. Any submission exceeding the permitted length will be rejected. The first page must include the title of the paper, author(s), affiliation(s), and the email address of the corresponding author. Template files both for Microsoft Word and Latex formats are available on the Online Paper Submission System.
- Papers must be submitted in Portable Document Format (PDF) before the deadline. Please note that the online paper submission system **will not accept any submissions after ~~April 26, 2026~~ May 15, 2026**.
- Submitted papers must be scientifically rigorous, original and previously unpublished. They should clearly describe the methodology and findings, supported by sufficient results.

Academic Category – Selection Process

- All submitted papers for Academic Category will be carefully reviewed by the Technical Program Committee (TPC).
 - ✓ All papers are subject to a **single-blind peer-review process**.
 - ✓ Each paper is independently evaluated by at least two qualified reviewers according to criteria of novelty, technical quality, clarity, and relevance to the scope of the IWAC 2026.
 - ✓ Each paper will be accepted/rejected based on the feedback provided by those reviewers.
 - ✓ Author will receive a notification of acceptance/rejection with feedback comments on the review results.
 - ✓ Authors of accepted papers may revise their papers based on the comments in the final camera-ready version.
- Authors of accepted papers must submit the final camera-ready version with necessary changes requested by the TPC by **August 31, 2026**.
- Authors of accepted papers will be invited to give an oral / poster presentation at the workshop.
- Best Paper Award and Best Poster Award will be selected from the papers submitted and accepted to the Academic Category.
 - ✓ Best Paper Award:
Selected from oral presentation papers based on peer-review results and presentation evaluation by the TPC.
 - ✓ Best Poster Award:
Selected from poster presentation papers based on voting by oral and poster presenters.
- Students can submit their papers under the Student Paper category, provided that the First Author must be a student pursuing an academic degree at the time of initial submission. Best Student Paper Award and Best Student Poster Award will be selected from the papers submitted and

accepted to the Academic Category.

- ✓ Best Student Paper Award:
Selected from oral presentation papers based on peer review results and presentation evaluation by the TPC.
- ✓ Best Student Poster Award:
Selected from poster presentation based on voting by oral and poster presenters.
- Accepted papers will be published in the workshop proceedings and will be submitted for inclusion in the J-Stage database. Papers that are not presented at IWAC2026 will not be included in the database.

- Selected high-quality papers will be nominated for a journal publication by the Japan Society for Aeronautical and Space Sciences (JSASS). Nominated papers will be re-reviewed according to JSASS guidelines. Note that publication fee of accepted papers for JSASS journal publication will be paid from this workshop.

Interchange Category – Paper Submission

- Paper selection in the Interchange Category will be based on submitted papers with **a standard length of 1 page and a maximum length of 8 pages**. Any submission exceeding the permitted length will be rejected. The first page must include the title of the paper, author(s), affiliation(s), and the email address of the corresponding author. Template files both for Microsoft Word and Latex formats are available on the Online Paper Submission System.
- Papers must be submitted in Portable Document Format (PDF) before the deadline. Note that the online paper submission system will **not allow any submission after the submission deadline of April 26, 2026 May 15, 2026**.

Interchange Category – Selection Process

- Each paper will receive a notification of acceptance/rejection.
- Authors of accepted papers will be invited to give an oral / poster presentation at the workshop.
- Accepted papers will be published in the workshop proceedings. Please note that a paper will not be included in the workshop proceedings if it is not presented at the IWAC 2026.

Instructions for Accepted Papers

- Note that the information provided with your submission will be used to automatically generate the table of contents of the proceedings, authors index, and the final program of the workshop. Therefore, make sure to re-check the provided details are accurate.

- Authors of accepted papers must submit the final camera-ready paper by the required deadline through the Online Paper Submission System. Authors should update the initial submission with the camera-ready version by **August 31, 2026**.
- **Authors must attach a copy of the signed Copyright Transfer Agreement when submitting the camera-ready paper.** The Copyright Transfer Agreement form is available on the online paper submission system of EasyChair.
